Our Classes

2 Year Old Class

“TERRIFIC TODDLERS” Tuesday & Thursday 9:00-11:15am
A class that offers socialization and creative learning activities for children who turn two on or before June 1st.

3 Year Old Classes

3 Year / 2 Day Tuesday & Thursday 9:00-11:15am
A creative two-day learning class that stresses visual/motor coordination, verbal skills, and socialization. Children should be three on or before February 1st of the enrolled school year.



3 Year / 3 Day Monday, Wednesday & Friday 9:00-11:15am
OR Monday, Wednesday & Friday 11:45am-2:00pm
A learning class for three year olds that stresses visual/motor coordination, visual perception, math 1-10, language development, and socialization. Children should be three on or before August 31st.

4 Year Old Classes

4 Year / 3 Day Monday, Wednesday & Friday 9:00-11:15am
OR Monday, Wednesday & Friday 11:45am-2:00pm
A three-day learning program for four year olds that stresses visual perception, math recognition, 1-on-1 relationships, alphabet recognition, socialization, and the arts. Children should be four on or before August 31st.

4 Year / 5 Day Monday through Friday 9:00-11:15am
A learning program for children 4-5 years of age that stresses pre-reading skills, math readiness, visual perception skills, plus creative activities in all other subjects. Children should be four on or before August 31st.

Afternoon Classes



In addition to our regularly scheduled classes we offer an extended afternoon program that incorporates more creative learning time for our three and four year old students. These classes incorporate a variety of subjects and hands-on experiences. Afternoon classes are dismissed at 2:00pm and are offered five days a week.

Students must be potty trained to attend afternoon classes. Each student will need to pack a lunch for the days they attend.

Sign-up for these classes will be in September and will be filled on a first-come, first-serve basis.

Drop-ins will be permitted if space allows.
