

Camp Guidelines

PLEASE NOTE:

- Space for camp is limited. Children **MUST** be pre-registered in order to guarantee their spot.
- Pick-up is promptly at 2:00 PM. Late fees will be charged after 2:00 pm.
- Please pack your child's bathing suit, towel, and lunch EVERYDAY.
- Summer Camp is held outside for the majority of the day. Please apply sunscreen each day before camp.
- As space is limited, there are **NO** refunds for weeks that children do not attend. Please see the office if you need to change your scheduled weeks.
- Drop-ins are permitted if slots are available. A payment of \$20.00 per day is due that day for drop-in slots.



Rates for 2017

The rates for Summer Camp 2017 are:

\$85.00 per week per child

\$80 per week for siblings



There is also a \$25.00 registration fee per family for camp. **As space is limited, a non-refundable deposit of the registration fee and half of the total summer tuition is due with the application.** (See rate chart on registration form.) Please contact the Eastminster Preschool office if you have any questions regarding the registration process.

REMEMBER:

- Space is limited and registration is on a first come, first serve basis.
- The deposit is due with registration. The remainder of your child's fees are due at the start of each week of camp.
- Failure to pay the deposit or full camp tuition may result in losing your child's spot for camp.
- Registration will be confirmed via email upon receipt of your child's registration form and deposit.

Lunch & Snack


