FIRST: I direct that all of my debts and funeral expenses be paid.

SECOND: I give, devise and bequeath all the rest, residue and remainder of my estate, real and personal, of whatever nature and wheresoever situate, unto my wife, Beulah A. Plath, if she survives me.

THIRD: If my wife, Beulah A. Plath, does not survive me, then I give, devise and bequeath all the rest, residue and remainder of my estate, as aforesaid, in equal shares unto the following three organizations:

As you know, The York Bank is executor of the estate of George L. Plath, who died on November 27, 1995. You are named in the will to receive one-third of the residue of the estate. A copy of the will is enclosed for your information.

Notice to creditors was published immediately following our appointment. That notice must be published three times, and all claimants have four months from the first publishing to submit claims against the estate.

If there are no unexpected problems, distribution should be made within ten to twelve months of the date of Mr. Plath's death.

A copy of our fee schedule is enclosed for your information. We do not yet know the exact value of the estate, but it will probably approach \$280,000.00. Our fee in an estate this size is \$13,200.00, plus 6% of income collected.

We will prepare an inventory as of date of death and give you a copy. That should be ready by March 1, 1996.

When administration is completed, we will prepare and file a first and final accounting with the Orphans' Court. We will give you a copy of that accounting.


