



Eastminster Presbyterian Church Guidelines for Wedding Photographers/Videographers

NOTE: One copy has been provided to the Bride & Groom; and one copy should be given by them to each photographer and/or videographer.

The staff of Eastminster Presbyterian Church appreciates that the wedding party desires a photographic record and/or video of this momentous occasion and will work with you and your photographers/videographers to insure this.

Listed below are guidelines that should be provided to each of them and adhered to:

1. A wedding ceremony is a service of Divine Worship to God. As such, all parties will conduct themselves in a reverent and worshipful manner.
2. The Pastor is in charge of all aspects of the service.
3. No additional lighting may be used.
4. At no time shall the photographers/videographers be noticeable or a distraction to any of the attendees.
5. The photographer/videographer shall place his/her tripod in the side aisle behind the last pew or in the Narthex.
6. Photographers and/or videographers shall not stand or wander in front of attendees prior to or during the service.
7. From the time the Pastor enters the Sanctuary until the recessional, there will be NO flash photography.
8. We encourage photography prior to and/or following the ceremony.
 - a. You are welcome to utilize our beautiful campus as a backdrop for photos.
