Policy on Celebration of the Lord's Supper

It has been the policy at Eastminster to celebrate the Lord's Supper the first Sunday of each month, Maundy Thursday, and Christmas Eve. Since the programs of the Church function on a school year basis, the determination of the dates for communion should be approved at the August Session meeting. Each year's dates should be reviewed and adjusted as needed to fit the schedule of the Church.

The Worship Committee is responsible for preparing the elements for communion. Eastminster uses grape juice for communion.

For those members who cannot attend worship and want to participate in communion, they need to notify the pastor. The pastor will attempt to have an elder or deacon accompany him to serve the shut in or nursing home bound member.
