

Eastminster Presbyterian Church Officers of the Corporation

In the state of Pennsylvania it is a requirement for a church to form a legal corporation. As such, a corporation must have an annual meeting and elect officers. Eastminster holds an annual corporation meeting in conjunction with the annual meeting of the congregation. At the corporation meeting, a President and Secretary are elected. It has been Eastminster's practice that the moderator of the Board of Trustees is elected the President of the corporation and the Clerk of the Session is elected the Secretary of the corporation. The terms of office are one year.
