
Dear Ms. Lindsay;

After a conversation with Ruling Elder Jack Hynd as the Clerk of Session of Eastminster Presbyterian Church, the Presbytery of Donegal is able to attest that there is a close relationship between the Eastminster Presbyterian Church and the Eastminster Preschool. The covenant relationship between the church and the preschool is marked by the Eastminster Preschool Board being elected by the congregation, a representative of the Preschool Board being present at Session meetings, and by regular reports being given to the Session by the Preschool of its ministry and activities.
